- 3.1 HY/2011/08 - Tunnel Buildings, Systems and Fittings, and Works associated with Tunnel Commissioning
 AECOM briefed Members on the progress of works under Contract No. HY/2011/08 - Tunnel Buildings, Systems and Fittings, and Works associated with Tunnel Commissioning (CC). Noted
- 3.1.1 Construction activities carried out by CC since CWB commissioning: Noted
- a. Road resurfacing works and road marking works at Connaught Road Central elevated road westbound, Fenwick Pier Street and Central Tunnel Portal of CWB;
 - b. Installation of parapets at Connaught Road Central elevated road westbound;
 - c. Tree transplant at Edinburgh Place.
- 3.1.2 The upcoming construction activities to be carried out by CC: Noted
- a. Road resurfacing works and road marking works at Central Tunnel Portal of CWB, the elevated road near Rumsey Street Flyover, Connaught Road Central westbound near China Travel Building, Connaught Road Central westbound near Statue Square;
 - b. Replacing the existing directional signs at Lung King Street, Eastern Street, etc;
 - c. Removing the temporary directional signs at Convention Avenue, Pedder Street, etc;
 - d. Road junction improvement works at Man Yiu Street, Lung Wo Road and Edinburgh Place.

4 Introduction to the Temporary Traffic Arrangement (TTA) Schemes

- 4.1 AECOM briefed Members on the special traffic arrangements to be implemented in late September. All lanes of Connaught Road Central elevated road eastbound would be closed for five midnights in late September. There would be clear and sufficient traffic signs guiding motorists to other districts via Connaught Road Central surface road. Noted
- All lanes of Man Kat Street would also be closed for approximately eight midnights in the remaining days of late September. There would be clear and sufficient traffic signs guiding motorists to other districts via Man Kwong Street.
