CENTRAL—WAN CHAI BYPASS AND ISLAND EASTERN CORRIDOR LINK

Amendments under section 7

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to amend the works originally shown on Plans Nos. 92995/GAZ/1000 to 92995/GAZ/1008 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 4767 published under section 8(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) on 27 July 2007 and 3 August 2007. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plans Nos. 92995/GAZ/1000A, 92995/GAZ/1005A, 92995/GAZ/1006A, 92995/GAZ/1007A and 92995/GAZ/1008A (the 'Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which the Amendment Plans and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed amendments is as follows:—

- (i) deletion of the proposed temporary breakwater to the north of the north breakwater of Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter;
- (ii) deletion of the proposed temporary piled wave walls to the north of the east breakwater and the north breakwater of Causeway Bay Typhoon Shelter; and
- (iii) revision of the proposed limit of works area.
